Pillar 1: Learning, Teaching & Assessment

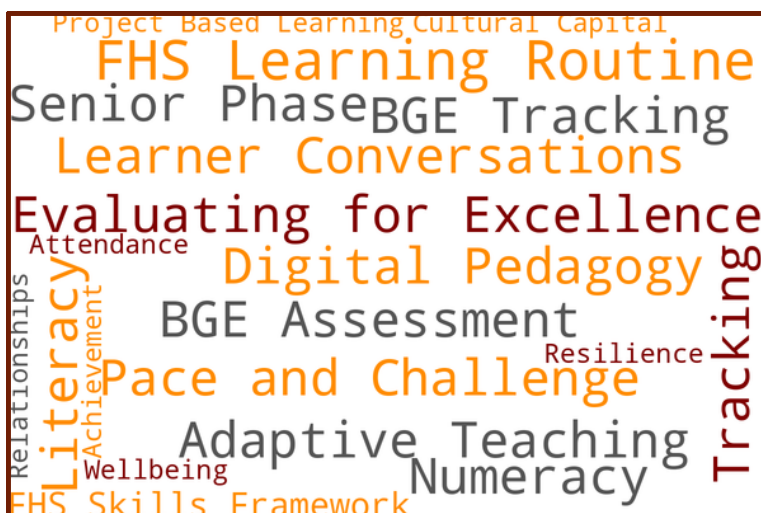
- We are focusing on high-quality classroom practice so every lesson supports progress
